#### 5) Our common home as a planetary network: what we buy is what we are.

The implications of our consumption habits are global: any city of 250,000 inhabitants buys products and services from the whole world – and we have choices, which give us power. If the 3.5 million inhabitants of the Greater Montreal Metropolitan Community buy green, we change the way land- and seascapes are used all around, first in the "greenbelt" that feeds our city, and then the entire planet. Even hundreds of informed consumers can make a difference: the "handprint of our plate" can be measured on people and ecosystems around the world.

In the late 90s, the 20+ millions of inhabitants of Sao Paulo City in Brazil were called upon by environmental organizations to curb illegal deforestation by demanding "certificates of origin" for all wood, fiber and timber products they bought, thus avoiding illegal producers. Working with the large distributors and furniture stores, and coupled with improved monitoring and enforcement, these measures resulted in the largest reduction in deforestation since measurements began in the Amazon – tens of thousands of miles away from Sao Paulo! A part of those measures was reverted more recently through political change, but in many cases consumer mobilization has made businesses better at caring for the environment than governments. The city of Montreal works with its citizens on many best practices (<u>https://montreal.ca/en/articles/six-concrete-actions-favour-biodiversity-montreal-5461</u>) and Cote St Luc's residents have ensured that no pesticides will be used in the municipality (<u>https://cotesaintluc.org/services/environment-and-waste/eco-csl/green-spaces-pesticides/</u>).

Our spiritual life can also be concerned with unbridled profit-making affects and ruins lives, cultures and the planet.
