

Please join us as we enter into our 2nd Sunday of Advent. We continue our journey towards the great encounter in peace, an inner peace that comes when we fully embrace a deep relationship with the one we are waiting for.

ADVENT TWILIGHT RETREAT - Virtual Event with Fr. Raymond Lafontaine - Dec. 10 & 11, 2021 "I must go. People must know."

Dear Friends and Fellow Pilgrims:

As this pandemic persists, it feels like we will have to wait yet longer to celebrate Christmas in the manner to which we are accustomed. Yet, our challenge during Advent is to walk together: in hope, in solidarity, in joy at the greatest Gift we have received: Jesus, Emmanuel, God with us.

On Friday and Saturday (December 10 - 11) before the third Sunday of Advent ("Gaudete! Rejoice!"), the Office for English Pastoral Services invites you to a guided Twilight Retreat, entitled "I must go. People must know." This Retreat will incorporate two elements:

1. On Friday evening, December 10th (on your own), the viewing of "The Shepherd", a 25-minute pilot episode of the award-winning multi-season miniseries on the life of Jesus and his disciples, "The Chosen", followed by some questions to guide your prayer and personal reflection;
