
Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.)

Pilgrimage to Oberammergau & Poland led by Deacon Brian Cordeiro & Fr. Raymond Lafontaine

This pilgrimage (Sept. 24 to Oct. 3, 2020) will take in a short stay at Munich and "The Passion Play"at nearby Oberammergau (which takes place only every 10 years) in Germany & then proceed to see many important pilgrimage & cultural sites in Poland. It will visit historic Krakow & its Jewish sector, the concentration camp at Auschwitz-Birkenau, the Salt Mine of Wieliczka (a UNESCO patrimonial site), the Sanctuary of Sister Faustina (devotion to the Divine Mercy), Our Lady of Czestochowa and the city of Warsaw.
