DEVELOPMENT & PEACE – "Reaping Our Rights"

Development and Peace – Caritas Canada, this Fall, the campaign is focusing on three countries where D&P - Caritas is actively involved with communities, Nigeria,

Columbia and Thailand.

Nigeria is greatly affected by the extraction industry (oil and metals). These industries are involved in land grabbing, resource theft, and contamination of the soil, water and air by private corporations. The soil is now contaminated to the depth of ten metres. In Nigeria they are working towards "Healing the Land." The **Due Diligence Legislation** is vital for the Nigerian communities affected, considering 60% of all extraction companies have their headquarters in Canada. So, what is **Due Diligence Legislation**? That it is mandatory for all Canadian companies to act responsibly, respect human rights and environmental rights, and that no Canadian company can trample on the rights of the people of the Global South.
