THE GIFT OF PEACE

As we journey through the Advent season, we come to the Second Sunday of Advent, where we reflect on the theme of peace. Peace is a fundamental aspect of the Christian faith, and it is a gift that Jesus offers to us. As the prophet Isaiah reminds us, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,

May we be inspired by the example of Jesus, the Prince of Peace, and may we strive to live out this kind of peace in our own lives.

WARDENS ELECTIONS

On **Sunday, December 15**, immediately following the **11 a.m. Mass**, our parish will hold an election for three positions on the Board of Wardens. The current three wardens who will be finishing their first three-year term plan to stand for election for their second three-year term. Other interested parishioners can also stand for election for these three positions.

To be eligible for this role, candidates must:

- Be a practicing Roman Catholic
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have been a registered member of our parish for a minimum of one year
- Reside within the boundaries of the parish:
 - NORTH The South side of Cote St. Luc Road between Beaconsfield & Walkley Avenues
 - SOUTH St. Jacques Street
 - **EAST** The West side of Beaconsfield Avenue from Cote St. Luc Road to St. Jacques
 - WEST The East side of Walkley Avenue from Cote St. Luc Road to St. Jacques Street

Nominees and Voters must also live within these Boundaries.
