MOVIE NIGHT COMING UP

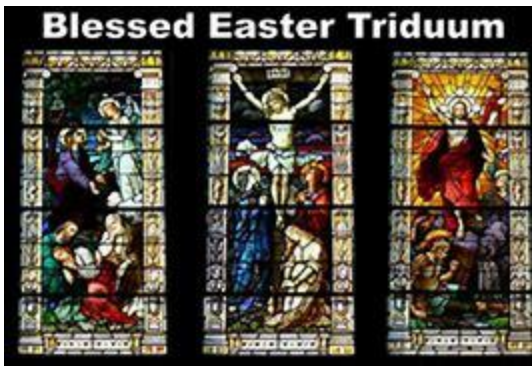

THE HOLY TRIDUUM: **A SACRED JOURNEY THROUGH HOLY WEEK**

The Holy Triduum is a three-day celebration that commemorates the paschal mystery of Jesus Christ, encompassing the Last Supper, the crucifixion, and the resurrection. 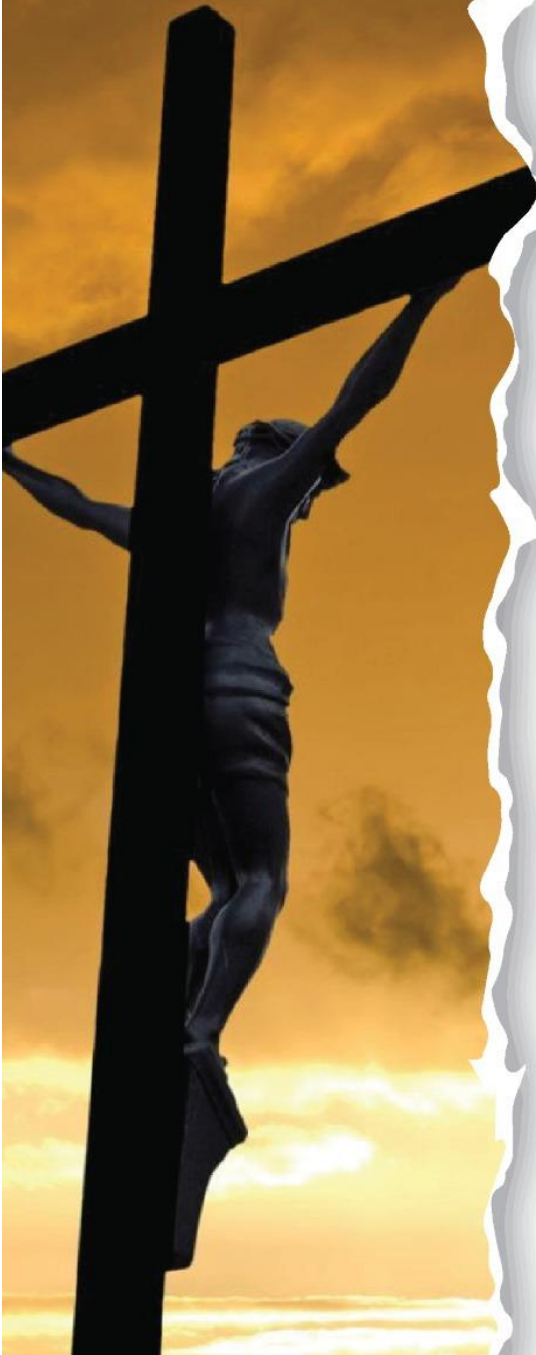
