






The <u>Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ</u>, historically known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi, is this feast day that highlights the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, — Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. The word "Eucharist" means thanksgiving and recall the Jewish blessings that proclaim — especially during a meal — God's works: creation, redemption and sanctification.

On the night before he died, Jesus shared one last meal with his Apostles. During this Last Supper, "he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me.' And likewise, the cup after they had eaten, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you.'" (Luke 22:19-20)

Taking him at his word when he said, "This is my body," and "This is my blood," the <u>Church teaches</u> that the bread and wine become the body and blood of Jesus at every Mass. St. John Chrysostom declared: It is not man that causes the things offered to become the body and blood of Christ, but he who was crucified for us, Christ himself. Because of its importance, the Church has a special feast day to recognize the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.
