BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT, WE STAND ON HOLY GROUND, FOR JESUS CHRIST IS TRULY PRESENT—BODY, BLOOD, SOUL, AND DIVINITY—HIDDEN UNDER THE HUMBLE APPEARANCE OF BREAD. ADORATION IS NOT ABOUT MANY WORDS OR ELABORATE PRAYERS; IT IS ABOUT PRESENCE. IN SILENCE, IN THE GENTLY LISTENING OF SCRIPTURE, OR IN THE QUIET MOVEMENTS OF THE HEART, WE ALLOW CHRIST—WHO IS ALREADY WAITING FOR US—TO SPEAK, TO HEAL, AND TO TRANSFORM US.
